"Pupils felt happy and safe at the school and knew they had adults around them who cared about them and who they could talk to if they needed support."

"Pupils valued the extensive support the school had put in place to support them with transition to secondary school."

"The ways staff are supported and valued at the school has led to a strong sense of belonging across the staff team."

"Feedback from parents indicated the school are highly effective at providing care and support to children and families when they are most in need in a sensitive and caring way whether this be in response to a long-term issue or in a crisis and that this support and care came from staff right across the school."
