We will keep this brief – we know that everyone is busy and there is a lot to do before the start of the school year and before you join our school community! We just wanted to take a few moments to introduce ourselves and to give you some key information about the PTA (Parent Teacher Association) ahead of the new school year.

Why does the School have a PTA

Our group is called 'Friends of The Discovery School' – or FODS for short. We are a committee of volunteers made up of parents, teachers and staff members, to run our registered charity.

The main function of our PTA is to support the school by raising as much money as we can to enhance, enrich and improve learning experiences for the children. We also provide those 'little extras' that make school memorable, from Easter egg hunts to leavers gifts. The new starters in Year R also receive a small gift at the start of term to help them with their transition into school life.

We also exist to bring the communities of school and home closer together because it makes sense for parents to be involved in the life of their chosen school.

Lastly, we're here for the simple reason that we want to get together socially, meet new people and have fun!

We might sound like an abstract group of people, but we're parents, carers, friends and allies – just like you. Not so long ago, we were new too.

What does the PTA do?

Over the past few years, we have proudly donated over £70,000 to the school.

This has funded the supply of 30 iPads, outdoor play equipment, sound & lighting rigs for the school productions and the adventure trail.

This year we reached our target to raise over £15,000 to put towards exciting new projects that will be announced soon!

In previous years we have managed to donate £11,000 for 30 iPads and paid for outdoor play equipment.

As well as this, we pay for a variety of small gifts and activities for the children to enjoy throughout the year!

Our team of volunteers can provide all this by organising a range of fundraising events throughout the year – including school fayre's, fireworks, book sales, raffles, quiz nights and other family events.

What are the PTA Goals for 2024/2025?

This year we are aiming to raise additional funds for the completion of the all-weather **MUGA sports pitch**.

Another project we are aiming for is 'Zones of Play' – Each zone in the playground has a different theme and activity section with equipment.

Having a diverse world of playground zones can help change the dynamic of the playground. Introducing new markings that children may not have seen before, could be a great way in getting them to engage in new activities, and even start to build new relationships with other students.

This has already been achieved in key stage 2 and we want to push this to other key stages.

A small project is providing 'Eco Books' for the non-fiction in our school library.
